



Confirmation Preparation Expectations

9th & 10th Grade



All students must attend mass each week.

- Any mass at any parish will work. (Saturday or Sunday Mass)
- All candidates must attend **children's mass every month at Saint Therese**. This will be on the **first Sunday of each month at 10:30am**.

All students must attend class.

- Classes will be monthly, in the evening from 5-6:30pm.
- Parents must attend the 2 family formation classes we will have in December & March.

All students must complete a total of 20 volunteer service hours.

- Service hours can be obtained in 2 categories:
 - **Service towards others.** This can be done through the parish, community, and/or family. Examples can be found on our parish website under "Confirmation Preparation".
 - **Strengthening your spiritual life.** This can be done through participation in the ample church traditions and sacraments the Catholic church offers. This includes participation in Adoration, Stations of the Cross (lent), the Sacrament of Reconciliation, bible study, etc. More details can be found on our parish website under "Confirmation Preparation."
- The 20 total hours (2 yr period for 10th graders, 1 yr period for 9th) should be a mix of strengthening your spiritual life and serving others.
- Volunteer forms must be filled out for all the services provided and/or participation in the parish. Volunteer forms can be found on our parish website under "Confirmation Preparation." Copies are also available in our parish kitchen and office.

Students must complete a saint report (10th graders) or saint project (9th graders) on chosen saint.

Students must write a letter to Father requesting the Sacrament of Confirmation.
