

Confirmation Information Sheet

- A week or so before the ceremony, you will receive rehearsal timing, photo instructions, seating, and parking info along with maps to help direction.
- Students are requested to be seated at the cathedral 1:15 minutes prior to the time of the Confirmation. Rehearsal and photos will be 60 Minutes before the ceremony.
- We request Confirmandi families try to stay to 7 guests per family as a general rule.

Please see the following attire guidelines for Confirmation. It is a holy celebration and our outward presentation should reflect that!

Both Gentleman & Ladies

- Candidates should feel comfortable and confident on the day of confirmation. If they constantly need to adjust or pull on their outfit to cover themselves, it will distract from their full participation in the ceremony.
- No athletic shoes, boat shoes, casual sandals, flip flops, or CROCS.
- No jeans, shorts, sweats, pajamas, leggings.

Gentleman:

- Dress shoes with dark colored socks. No Michael Jackson vibes.
- Dress pants and belt.
- Dress shirt.
- Tie/bowtie optional.
- Sport coats/Blazers or suits may also be worn, if desired.

Ladies:

- Dress shirt & slacks, dress, or jumpsuit that meet the below guidelines are allowed.
- Dress flats, dress shoes, or heels/wedges. (Make sure you can walk in them!)
- Skirts should come no higher than fingertip length when both standing and bowing.
- When bowing, no underwear, shorts or excessive cleavage should be seen.

- No midriff/low back cutouts or open back tops - Shoulders/Upper back should be 90% covered. Midriff should be 100% covered, sorry no crop tops.
- No strapless or spaghetti strap shirts/dresses without a cardigan or cover worn when inside.
